Kit cars



Late-model cars may be eligible if not driven as daily transportation, have a performance aspect, and considered a future collectible.

#### Exotic



Generally of foreign make, an exotic has limited production, high performance (500+ hsp, high power to weight ratio, extreme engineering), and higher cost to repair. It's also not driven daily.



Kit cars (a.k.a. replica or tribute vehicles) either replicate a previously manufactured model or may be a one-of-a-kind design.

#### Special interest



Special interest vehicles, such as a fire engine, military equipment, or vintage tractor, originally had a specific purpose, but are now typically appear in a show or parade.

Active race cars are covered when not on the track or in an active pit. Retired cars kept for show or in a collection should be written as a non-registered vehicle.
